No Pony or Horse to compete in more than 3 classes

Correct safety hard hats to BS standard must be worn

We recommend the wearing of Body protectors

All droppings to be picked up

The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel any classes at their discretion

Dogs must be kept on leads

Young children to be supervised at all times

The organisers advise ALL participants to have third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in ALL events, this insurance should extend to livestock and vehicles

Officials and competitors only allowed in rings
