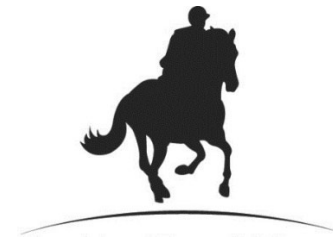


Health And Safety Requirements:

**DIRECTIONS TO STOCKLAND LOVELL**

The map illustrates the route to Stockland Lovell. It starts at Hinkley Point, where a yellow line leads to Hinkley Point Road. From there, the route goes south to the Cannington Village Roundabout. From the roundabout, the route splits into two directions: one leading west to A39 from Minehead and another leading south to A39 from Bridgwater. Both routes converge at the roundabout, which then leads north to Stockland Lovell Manor. A yellow circle with a horse silhouette is placed on the road between the roundabout and the manor, indicating the location of the Stockland Lovell sign.

**DIRECTIONS**

Leave the M5 motorway at J23 or J24 to Bridgwater. Take the A39 to Cannington. Follow the yellow Hinkley Point signs via the Cannington bypass. After approx 3 miles, look out for the Stockland Lovell sign on the left of a right hand bend. Stockland Lovell entrance is 300m on the right.
